Role Description

Project Brazen is seeking an audio production intern to help with our growing portfolio of incredible podcasts! This job is remote and it connects you with professionals around the world.

Required Skills:

- Audio engineering/editing experience, preferably in Adobe Audition
- Close attention to detail and an ability to work to the highest quality standards
- Excellent organizational, research, and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work independently, but also to function well as part of a team
- Basic knowledge of audio hardware (portable audio equipment etc.)
- Sound editorial judgment, i.e. knowing when to refer to the producer or exec producer

You'll Be Expected To:

- Cut down interviews using a paper script eg. an hour-long conversation down to 20 mins
- Edit audio, including cleaning tracks, editing interviews and features
- Select appropriate background music using a music library
- Be a part of the PB team - contribute ideas and help to develop existing content

Potential Projects:

- Assist with putting together Brazen Presents episodes and bonus content
- Help organize large collections of archival audio files

Benefits
