- General design admin work; management of WordPress backends; organizing files on Google Drive, Figma etc.

## Requirements:

- You must have a portfolio to be considered for the role
- Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Graphic Design or equivalent commercial experience (or currently pursuing a related degree)
- Fluent in Adobe CC, especially Photoshop and Illustrator; competent in Figma; skilled in typography, layout, and hierarchy
- Basic understanding or working knowledge of HTML and CSS; some knowledge of JavaScript preferred, but not required
- Possess a basic understanding of how the web development process works; preferably have basic knowledge of WordPress and SEO concepts
- Being research-oriented is a plus as we work with different softwares and applications
- Experience working with Trello and Slack, and experience working remotely preferred
- Stay up to date with the latest design trends and best practices
